It teaches children their limits and what behaviors are acceptable. It helps them grow into responsible adults.

> RULES HELP CHILDREN DEVELOP SELF-CONTROL

They also help kids understand what you want and need.

DISCIPLINE SHOULD BE FIRM, FAIR, AND CONSISTENT

Consistency means that you do the same thing every time. Always follow through on consequences. This builds respect for your rules.

ASK YOUR CHILDREN TO HELP CREATE THE HOUSE RULES

When they help create the rules, they are more likely to follow them.

FOLLOW YOUR OWN RULES

Children learn more from what you do than from what you say.

HELP YOUR CHILDREN REMEMBER RULES BY DISPLAYING THEM

Write down the rules on a poster or piece of paper. Include images for young children who can't read yet.
